

Minutes of Regular Meeting
Liberty Township, Licking County, Ohio
March 11, 2019

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, March 11, 2019 in the Liberty Township House. Bill Siegel, township trustee, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He stated the meeting was being recorded, and then led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel, Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole, trustees.
- A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the regular meeting minutes from January 14, 2019. Motion seconded by Bill Bogantz and passed with all yes votes.

Zoning Report

- Ed Wasem, Zoning Inspector: No permits
- Ray Hetterscheidt, Liberty Twp resident, questioned the swimming pool permit. Ed Wasem stated that it permits the placement of pool to property line and/or fencing.
- Bill Siegel revisited the update concerning the Zoning Resolution. Bill Bogantz has the Word document and suggests that the resolution be changed as issues arise. Bill Bogantz suggests the Zoning Board meet and discuss options for the Zoning Resolution Updates. The trustees agree to move forward with the zoning clerk getting the process started by setting a meeting with the Zoning Committee. Bill Bogantz did mention the second alternate position is still vacant on the Zoning Commission.

- St. Albans Fire Department presented the trustees with the last month report on runs in Liberty Township. The new Chief, Mike Tyson, introduced himself.

- The trash bins were replaced. A third bin was added. Rumpke will be emptying bins on a regular schedule and will be responsible for cleaning up the mess if overfilled.

New Business





- Gutter and downspout on buildings were replaced.
