

**Minutes of Regular Meeting**  
**Liberty Township, Licking County, Ohio**  
**February 11, 2019**

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, February 11, 2019 in the Liberty Township House. Bill Siegel, township trustee, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He stated the meeting was being recorded, and then led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel, Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole, trustees.
- A motion was made by Bill Bogantz to approve the regular meeting minutes from January 14, 2019. Motion seconded by Dave Cole and passed with all yes votes.

**Zoning Report**

- Ed Wasem, Zoning Inspector: No permits
- Ed Wasem stated that an issue regarding swimming pool permits was brought to his attention. Township should decide if a permit is required and if there is a charge for the permit. There is no liability to the township. Bill Siegel made a motion to collect a \$75.00 fee for all swimming pool permits issued by the zoning inspector. Dave Cole seconded the motion. The motion passed with all yes votes. The permit will take effect 30 days from today.

**Resident/Public Input**

- Township resident, Alan Huet, complimented Jeff Irvin, Township Road Supervisor, on the excellent condition of the township roads during the winter weather.

**Old Business**

- Bill Siegel reported that Jeff plowed and salted the roads and removed a tree.
- Bill Siegel reported that the new truck was picked up and that he is happy with the purchase. He feels the truck will do the township well.
- The 2004 township pickup truck will be put out for bid. The public Notice will be published in the Newark Advocate once during the week and once on a weekend. Bill Bogantz made a motion to sell the township pickup truck by sealed bid. Bill Siegel seconded the motion. The motion passed with all yes votes.
- Monroe Township provided the Fire/EMS total runs for 2018 in Liberty Township. Chief Wright shared the good news with the trustees regarding the much-improved rating of the fire department. The trustees agreed to send a letter of congratulations to the Monroe Township Fire Department.
- Recycle bins located at the township property continue to be an issue.





- The Final Appropriation Meeting will be February 25, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.
