

**Minutes of Regular Meeting
Liberty Township, Licking County, Ohio
January 14, 2019**

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, January 14, 2019 in the Liberty Township House. Bill Siegel, township trustee, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He stated the meeting was being recorded, and then led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel, Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole, trustees.
- A motion was made by David Cole to approve the regular meeting minutes from December 10, 2018. Motion seconded by Bill Bogantz and passed with all yes votes.

Zoning Report

- Ed Wasem, Zoning Inspector: No permits

Resident/Public Input

- Anthony Bonnell attended tonight's meeting to inquire about the mowing contract. He was informed the fiscal officer would notify him once the Public Notice has been placed.

Old Business

- Bill Siegel reported that Jeff has plowed and salted the roads several times during the snowy weather.
- Bill Siegel reported that he spoke with Coughlin about the delivery date of the newly purchased township truck. He was informed the truck would be started this week and take approximately 3 weeks. Bill did not agree with the length of time it is taking for the delivery of the truck that was purchased in November 2018. He called back and the tentative date for delivery is next Friday, January 25, 2019.

New Business

- The Annual Organizational Meeting was changed to Monday, January 28 at 5:00 p.m.
- Recycle Dumpsters: Bill Siegel mentioned the dumpsters are not getting emptied in a timely manner and overflowing to where the trustees have to pick up items all over the place and in the fields next to the township building. Bill questioned if the trustees should consider having them removed. The decision was to call Andrea at Licking County Recycle for more information and Bill Bogantz would construct a letter to the company's involved regarding issues.
- The trustees agreed to seek bids for lawn care service in March 2019.

- Receipts for the month of December were read. Receipts totaled \$22,363.22.
- Payments for the month of December were read. Payments totaled \$9,496.41.
- Minutes, permits, warrants, and vouchers were signed.
